









Early Childhood E Learning Menu Day 1 and 2

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Find objects from around your house, some lighter, some heavier; some taller, some shorter. 2. Put these objects into a bag, or a container. 3. Pick out two items from the bag, and to figure out which object is heavier/lighter or taller/shorter. 4. Put the objects back and play again, taking turns 	<p>Make a video of you counting to 10 and share it on Seesaw or email your teacher</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Put together four or five items that are all related. This can be any toys, food items, nature items that you have in and around your home. 2. Add an item that doesn't belong in the category. 3. Let your child look at the objects and determine which one doesn't belong. 4. If your child does not get it, then tell him/her the category and then ask which one does not fit in that category. 	<p>Count to 10 using different voices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A quiet voice • A loud voice • A scary voice • A low voice • A high voice • Like a monster
